Letter-writer John Clubine states that Hindu mobs in India and Pakistan oppress Protestants. Hindus in Pakistan are a tiny minority who have suffered genocide and persecution by Islamic fanatics; Christians are also a minority there and have also endured Islamist persecution.

In reality, Hinduism, like Judaism, does not believe in aggressive proselytization or conversion activities. On the contrary, South Asia has endured seven centuries of barbaric Islamic rule, where millions of Buddhists and Hindus were forcibly converted and thousands of their temples were destroyed.

Historians like William Durant recognize that Afghanistan and Pakistan were once Hindu kingdoms; today, they are over 90% Islamic. This demographic apocalypse was the result of genocide and forcible conversion to Islam.
